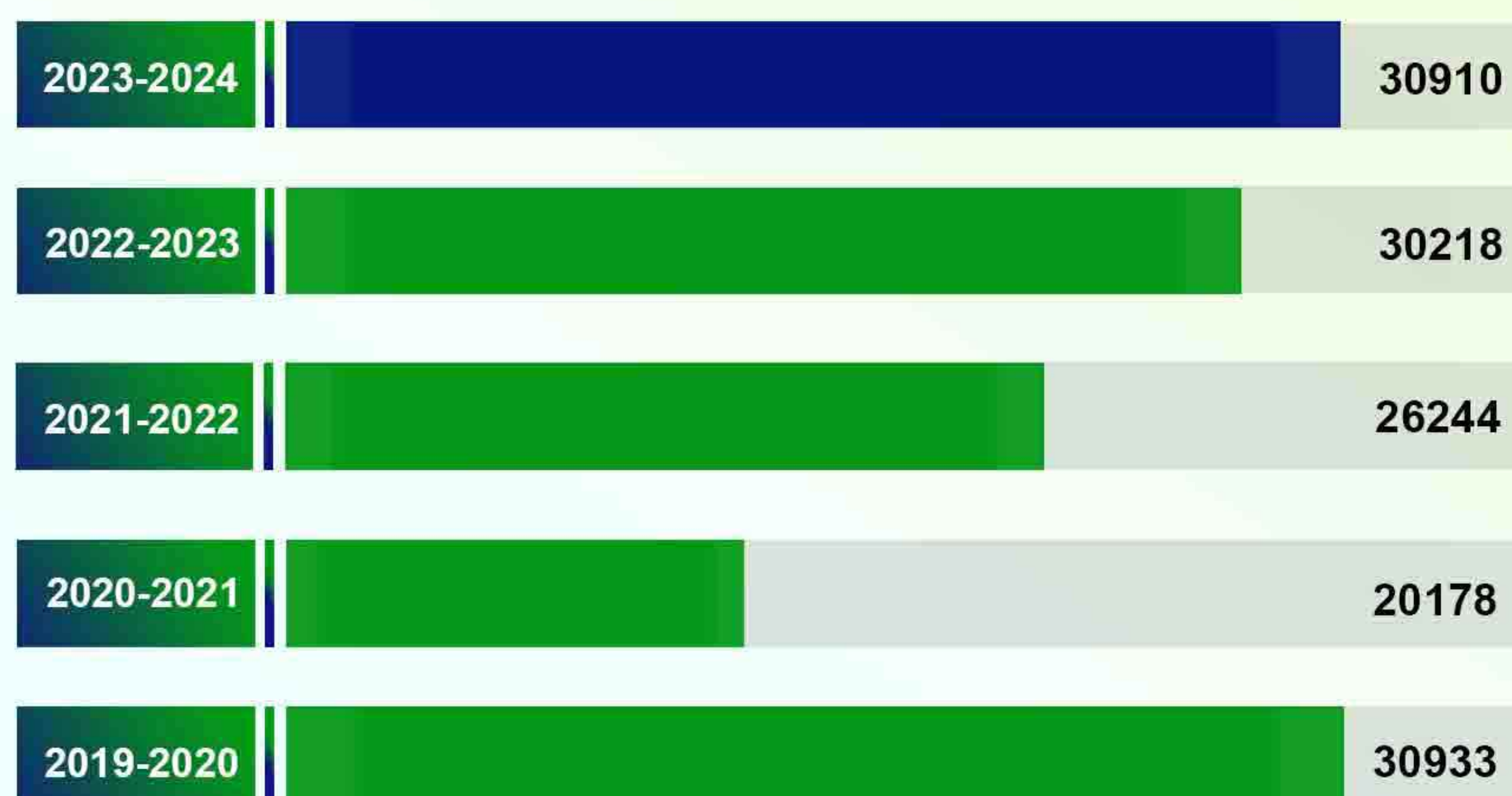

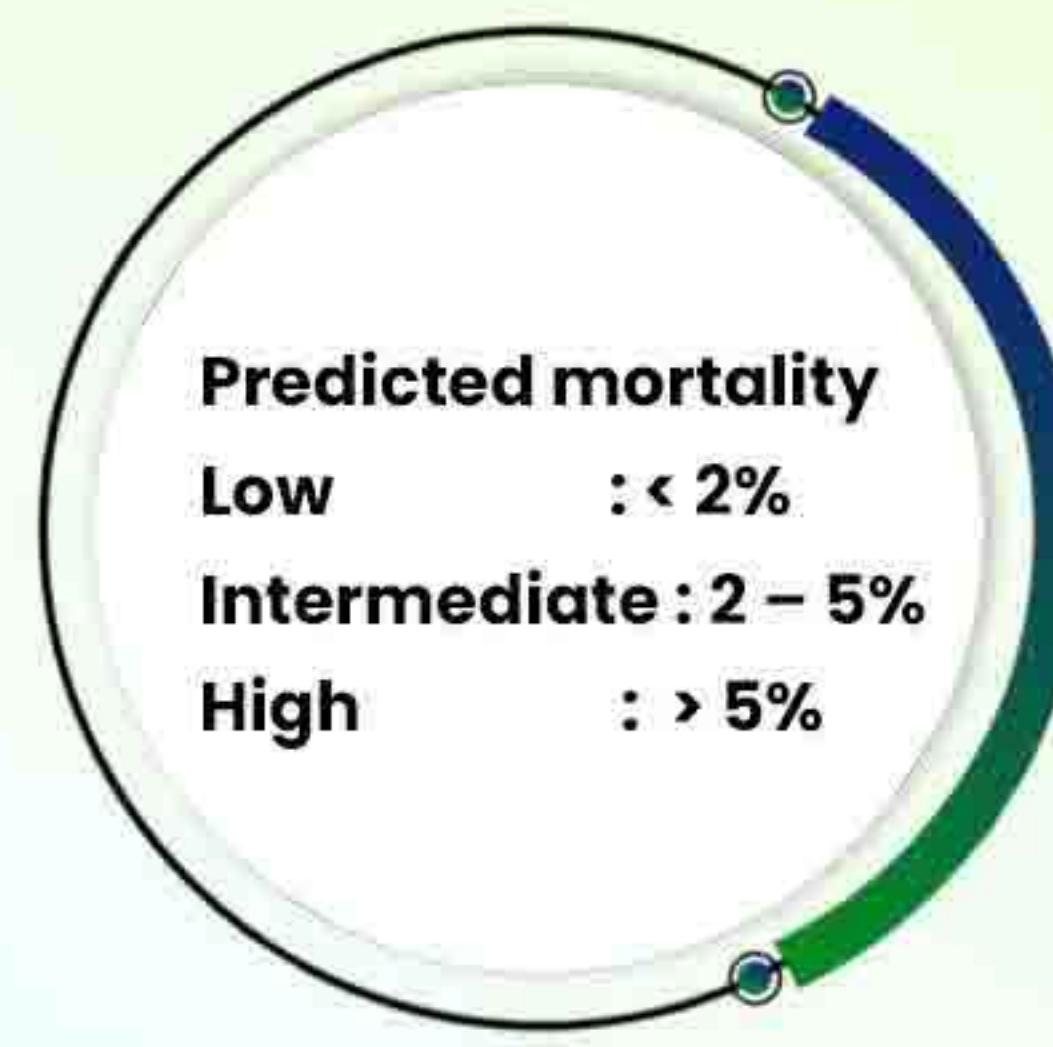
Risk adjusted mortality rate among cases presenting with STEMI, unstable angina/ NSTEMI.*

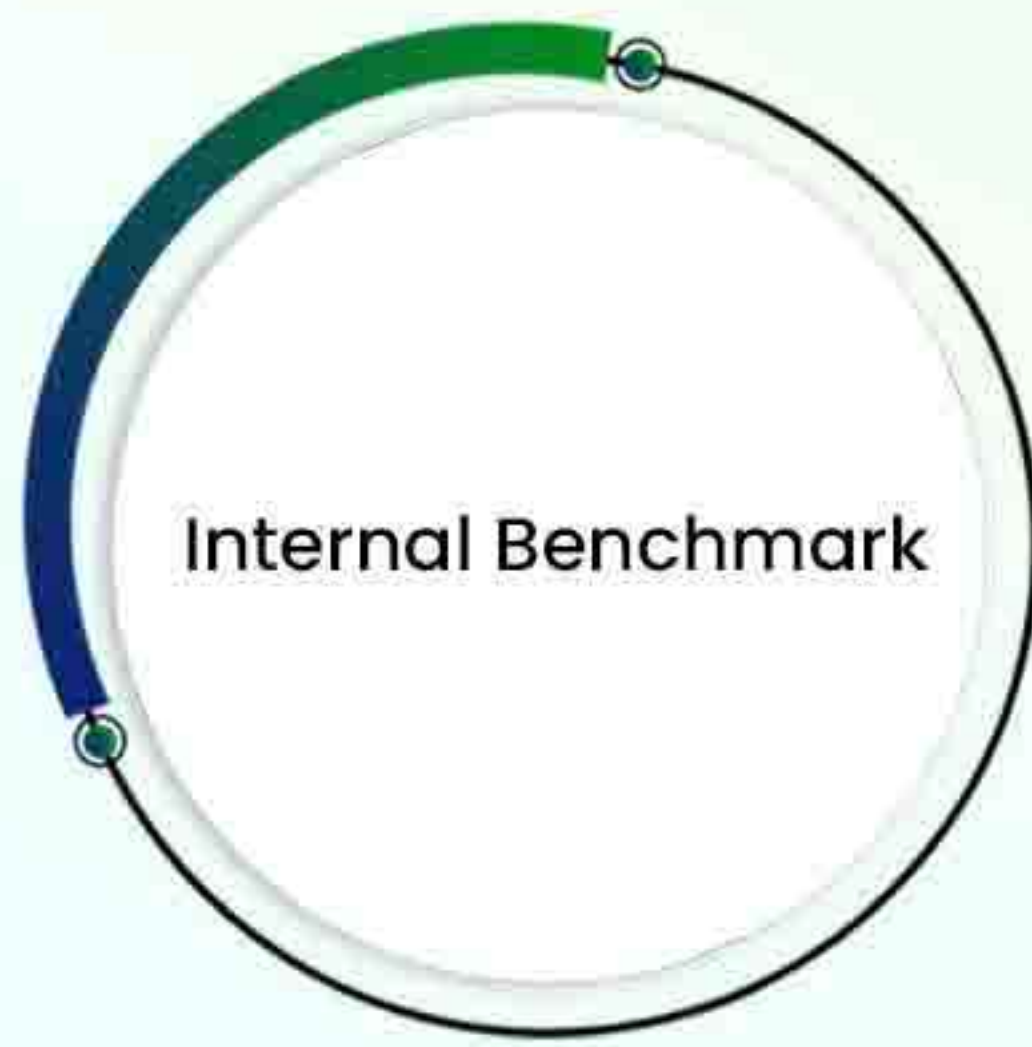

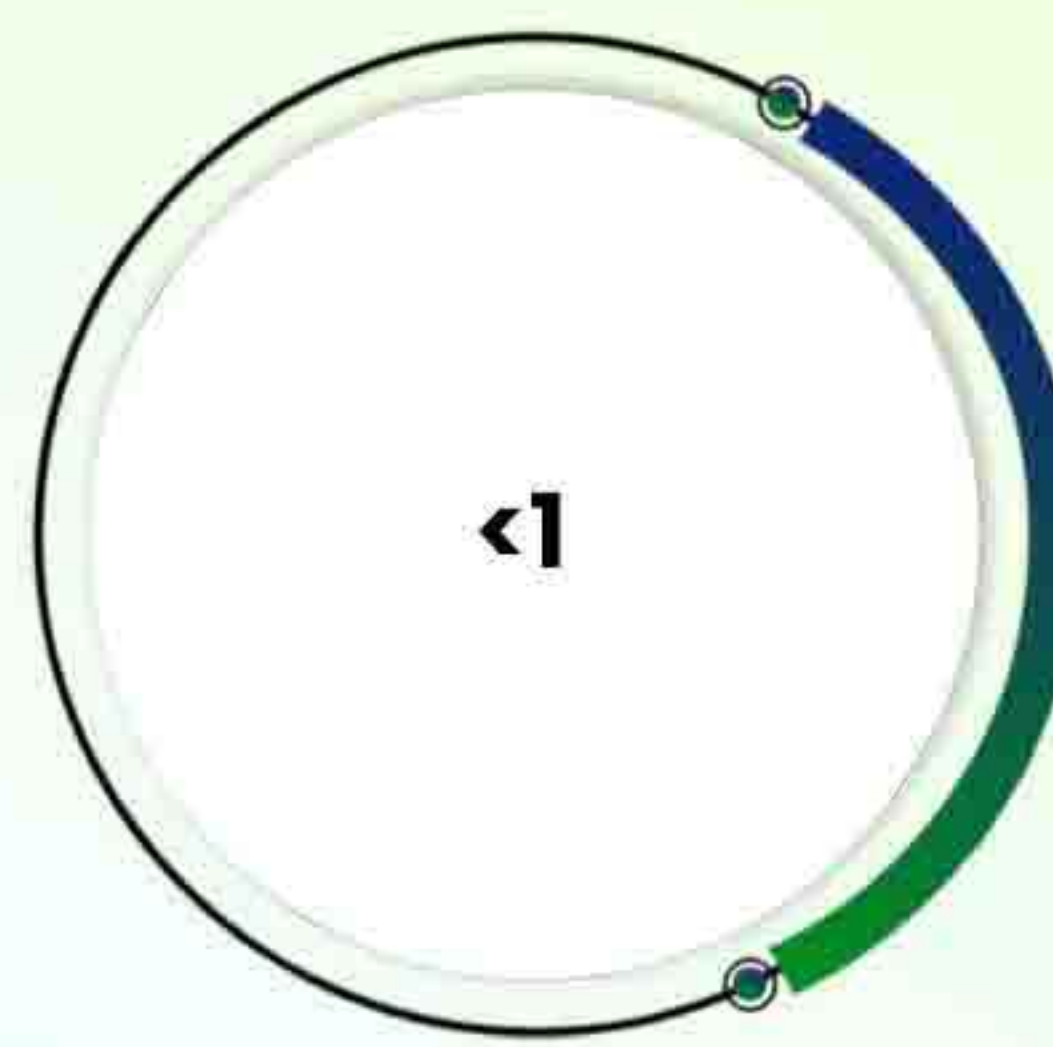
Standardised Mortality Rate for Adult Cardiothoracic ICU



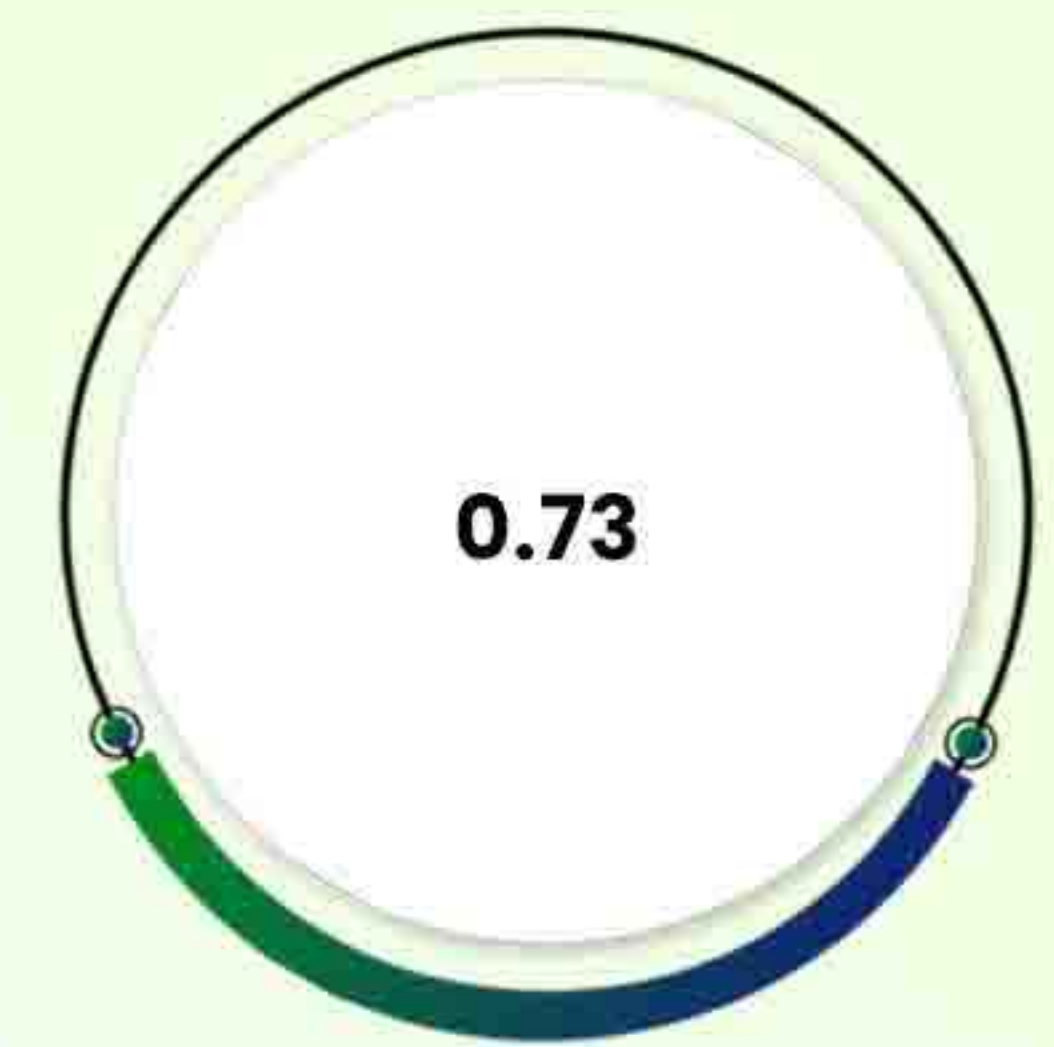

Mortality after isolated CABG



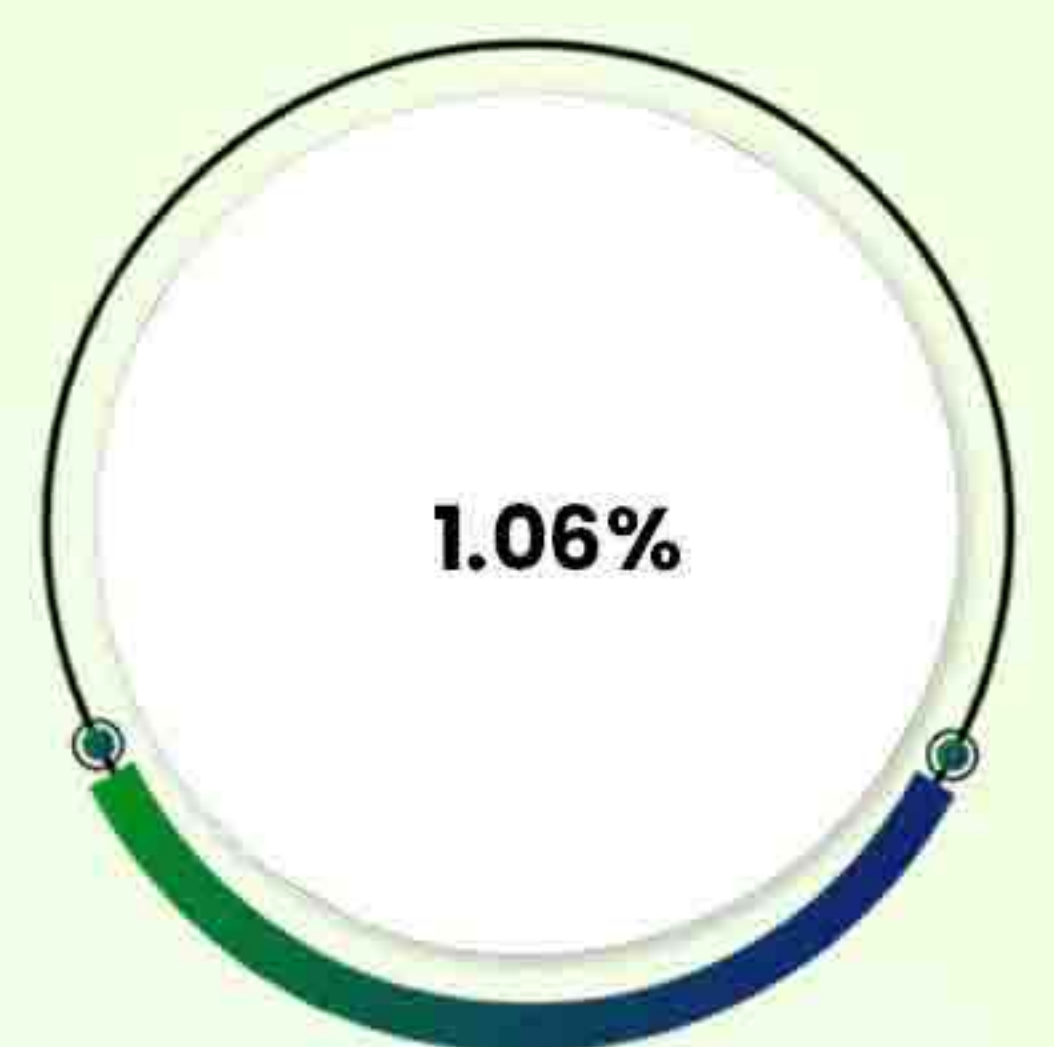

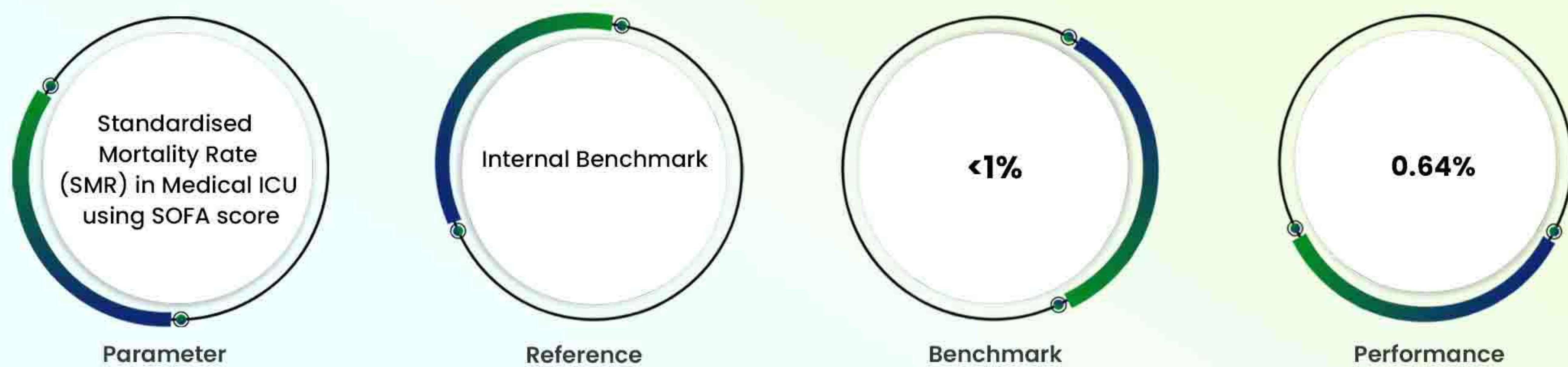
Incidence of pyrogenic reactions among Patients on Dialysis



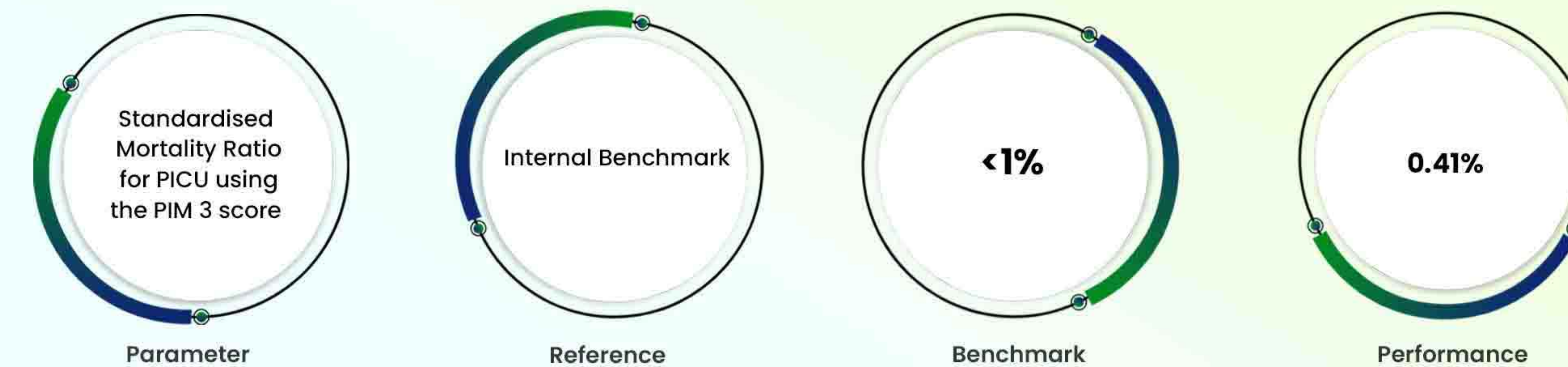
One year survival rate following Renal transplant



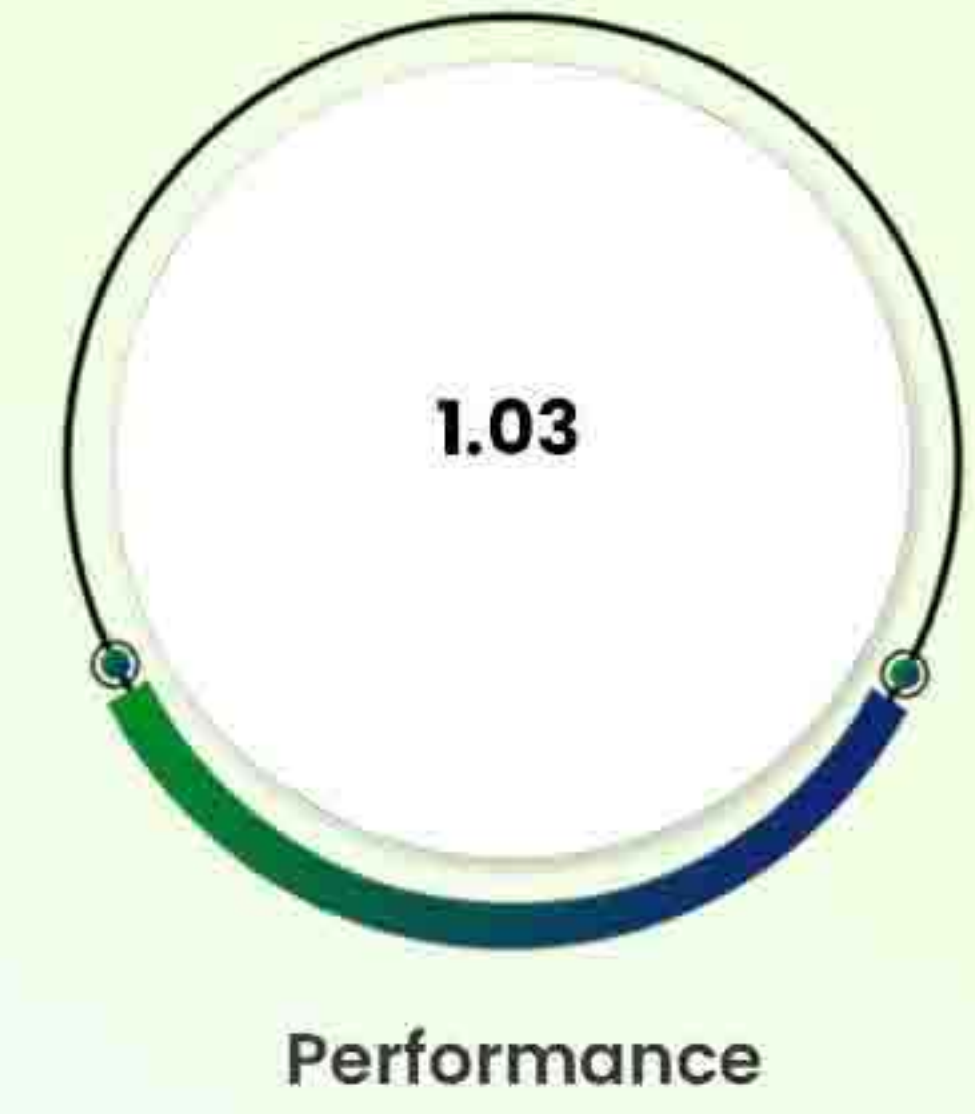
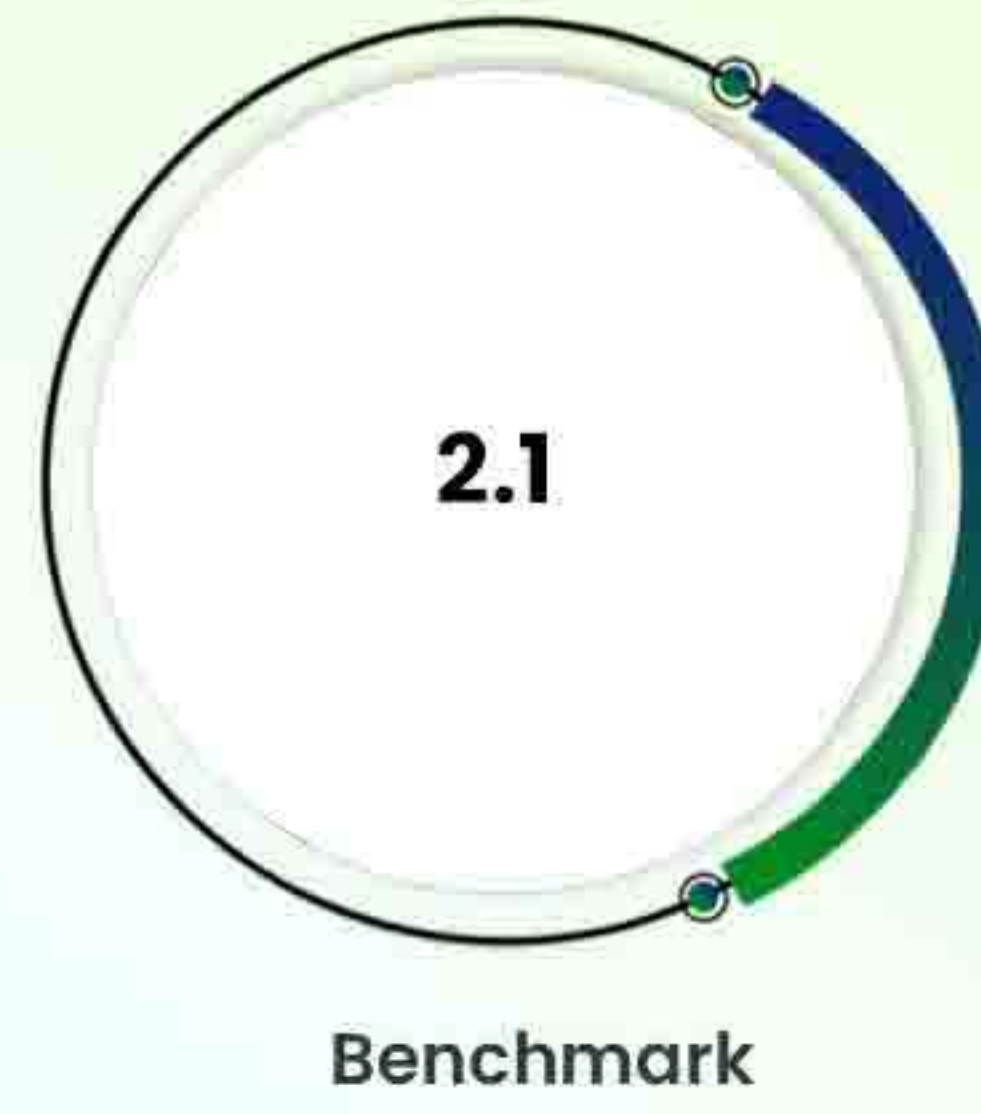
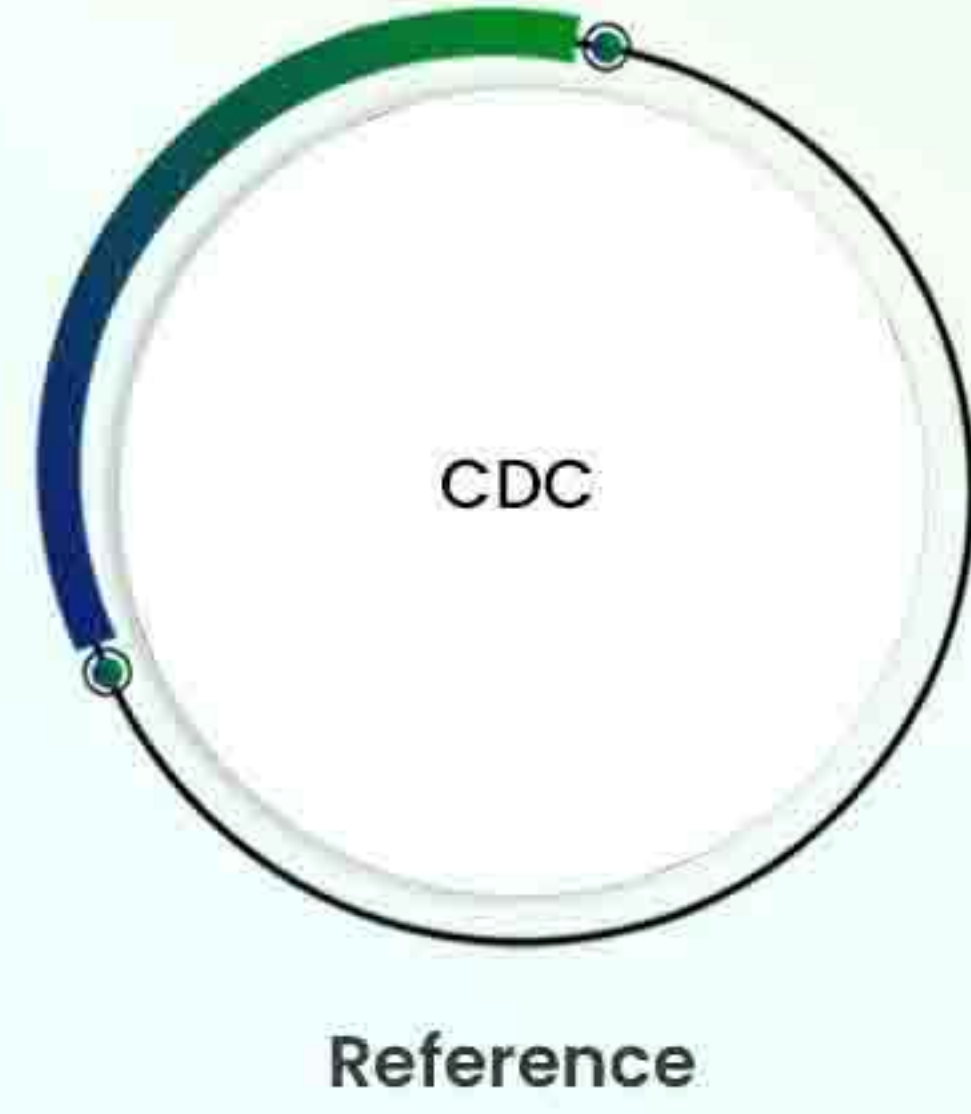
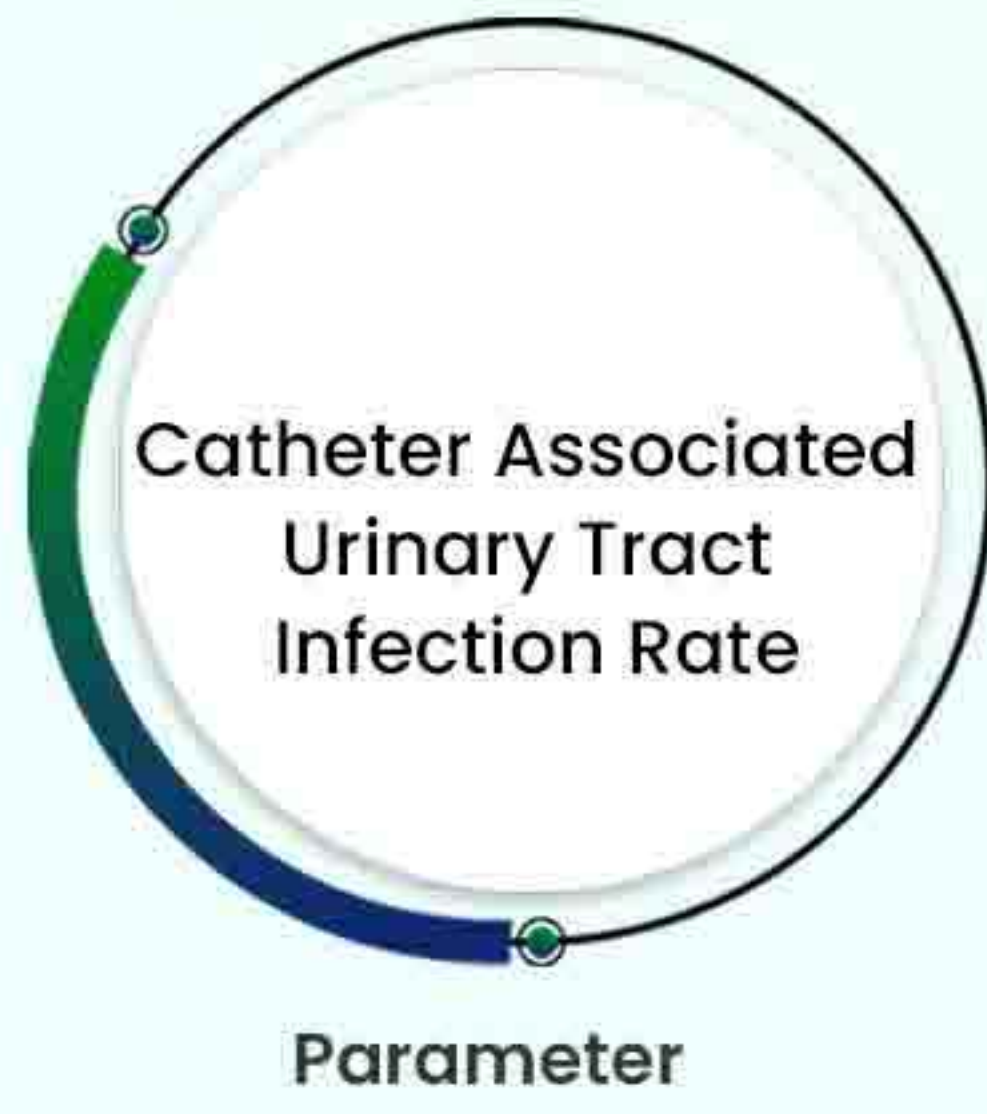

Childbhavanandha Rural Education and the Rural Health Centre - Veerapandi

GKNM Hospital opened a Rural Health Centre in Veerapandi village, Mettupalayam Road, on May 5th, 1995. The goal was to provide comprehensive healthcare to Selvapuram residents, situated about 4 km from the main road. The centre also serves nearby villages by offering medical consultations and treatments. This village was selected due to its isolation from civilization, despite being close to Coimbatore city, with no road access or bus services available.

Gudalur Municipality Middle School Anganwadi (Selvapuram) – A project of Upgradation - Inaugural Event

The renovated and upgraded Anganwadi was dedicated to the Gudalur Municipality Middle school at a function held on 8th February as a part of the Corporate Environmental Responsibility (CER). Free Medical Screening Camp for Rural & Tribal Community

GKNM Hospital conducts free medical camps for tribal and village communities in Tholampalayam villages in Coimbatore. These camps offer free oral, breast and Cervical cancer screenings for women as well as diabetes check-ups for both men and women. So far, nearly 7,000 ruralites have benefited from these initiatives.



Philanthropic Initiatives of the Hospital:

Ever since inception, G Kuppuswamy Naidu Memorial Hospital, under the aegis of The Kuppuswamy Naidu Charity Trust for Education and Medical Relief has been engaged in philanthropic activities. The hospital was established in 1952 providing free treatment to women and children. Over the years the scope of these activities has increased.

Veerapandi Rural Center provides free OPD Consultation, medicines and diagnostic services to the population in the near-by vicinity.

The community Oncology team provides free screening to women for Cervical, Breast and Oral Cancer. Under this program, over 10,000 women in and around Coimbatore have been screened.

Raksha is a 15-bed hospice which provides free palliative care to terminally ill cancer patients.

Ever since the CSR law was incorporated in India, the hospital through the Trust has been engaged in meaningful CSR projects, providing quality care to the under privileged sections of the society.

During the financial year 2023 – 2024 through these initiatives the hospital has supported the treatment of close to 340 children.

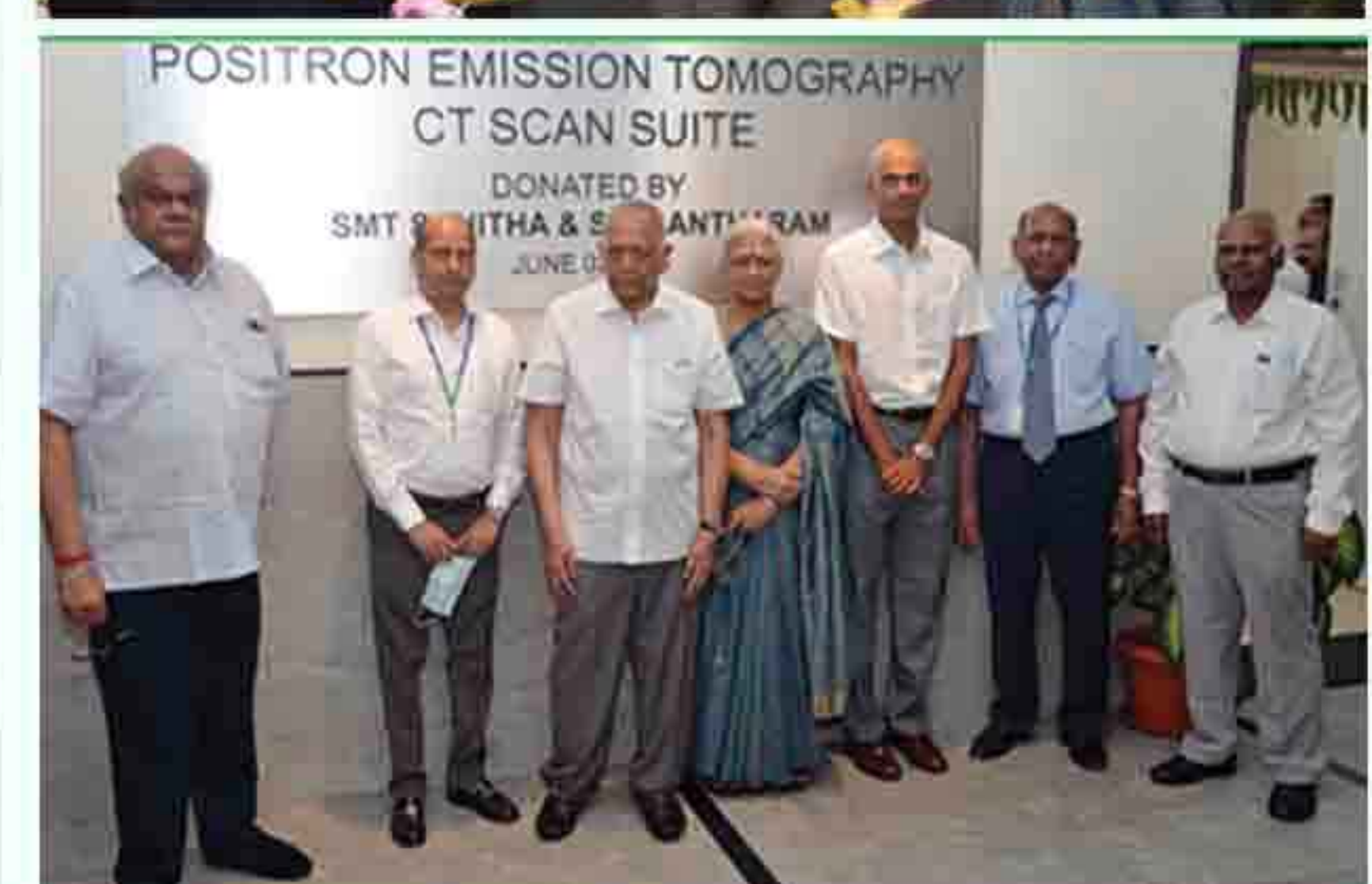
The 21st Annual Live Workshop "LiveSurge"
